This research-based program shows parents how to become learning facilitators so they may effectively meet the educational needs of their children. The program is composed of eight individual, interrelated modules that can be offered at your school site in Spanish and/or Haitian Creole. Upon completing this program, parents will have an effective and systematic method that will empower them to help their children reach Florida's high academic standards.

EL CLUB DE LIBROS

This local initiative in conjunction with Univisión, Channel 23 and Santillana USA promotes reading in Spanish. Participating schools are given the necessary readers and support to work with Spanish students to promote reading. The selected class prepares for a TV interview. The segment is aired once a week and the students and schools can see their work in the morning news on Channel 23.
